FOR5903 is a DFG Research Unit with a wide interdisciplinary and international scope, covering diverse dimensions of global urbanization processes under the novel framework of *"Sustainable* Rurbanity – Resources, Society, and Regulatory Systems". In the context of this project, a doctoral position is available addressing *RurbanLivestockSystems* - **Building rurban livelihoods through livestock** which integrates research approaches from **Social Anthropology** and Animal Sciences. The position cannot be shared. The main place of service is Göttingen, but extended field work in **Ghana's** Greater Accra region for several months per year will be required. Fitness for service in an urban agglomeration of the Global South is therefore mandatory.

Your tasks

- Preparing, conducting and coordinating anthropological field work on livestock businesses and people involved according to the theoretical approach of the Research Unit "Sustainable Rurbanity" and the work program of its subproject "RurbanLivestockSystems - Building rurban livelihoods through livestock"
- Close collaboration with a PhD student in animal science and the entire interdisciplinary and international team in the development and implementation of the research project
- Reviewing and analyzing relevant scientific literature
- Close cooperation and communication with academic partners in Ghana and Germany and additionally India and Morocco
- Participation in project-related seminars and workshops, and in international conferences by presenting achieved results
- Analysis of collected data, presentation and publication of results in project reports and scientific articles
- Contribution to writing of follow-up proposal
- General project management and administration
