The position is part of the project ZERN (Zukunft der Ernährung Niedersachsen - <https://zern-verbund.de>) and located at the Chair of Economics of Sustainable Agri-Food Systems (Prof Doris Läpple).

ZERN is a research and transfer network initiated by the University of Göttingen, the University of Veterinary Medicine Hannover and the German Institute of Food Technology in Quakenbrück, which aims to support the transformation of the agricultural and food system in Lower Saxony, which is under increasing pressure to adapt. The findings from the research alliance should enable the sustainable production, processing and marketing of food. The successful candidate will work on the ZERN project "Information Provision Strategies for Sustainable and Climate-friendly Production Methods: An Analysis of Lower Saxony's Dairy Sector".
