It is based at the chair of Economics of Sustainable Agri-food Systems (Prof Dr Doris Läßle). The position is part of the research project "[Building climate resilience in agricultural landscapes through social-ecological diversification, co-design and transdisciplinary learning \(AgRe-Lab\)](#)". AgRe-Lab will be funded by zukunft.niedersachsen, the joint science funding program of the Lower Saxony Ministry of Science and Culture and the Volkswagen Foundation. The transdisciplinary AgRe-Lab project is focusing on the adoption of climate and biodiversity measures, together with co-design processes, landscape governance, and transdisciplinary learning.

The successful candidate will work on the sub-project "Political Feasibility and Economic Efficiency of Climate and Biodiversity Measures". The sub-project explores how climate and biodiversity measures affect farm resilience and how stakeholders, media, and interest groups determine their implementation.
